Welcome to the 2009 KSG Lacrosse tournament. We are providing this information to assist you with this year's tournament. Please read everything carefully!

Tournament – Competition will be held Saturday and Sunday, August 1 & 2. Teams will play both days. Games will be played on five fields, two fields are turf, three fields are grass all on the Penn State Campus. These are the same fields used last year plus one.

Directions and Map – Enclosed are written directions and site map of the field locations on the Penn State Campus. Directions to the Jordon Center and Beaver Stadium are central to the four fields we are utilizing.

Hotels – It is the responsibility of each team/player/coach to secure housing for the tournament.

Rosters, entry forms and team payments – Your rosters, entry forms, and team payments are also requested in advance of the tournament. Enclosed please find the blank roster(s) and entry forms. Teams are permitted 22 players. Rosters are preferred to be completed online at www.keystonegames.com/coach.html

We would prefer rosters, individual entry forms and entry fees to be mailed to the KSG office on or before July 17th. Upon receipt of your information we will put together a finals program to distribute at the competition, for spectators and college coaches. The fee of \$60.00 per player should accompany each individual entry form. If you are not able to collect the individual entry forms and fees prior to July 16th, coaches should bring these materials to the KSG staff at the pre-competition meeting upon arrival. We will need your roster fully completed, by July 16th, mailed or emailed. Without your roster we will be unable to complete the program for distribution.

Uniforms – Teams will receive uniform shirts numbered 1-22 and will be X-Large. These shirts must be worn during competition. Each player will also receive one athlete souvenir shirt. Coaches (3 per team) will receive KSG Coaches shirts. These will be distributed at the coaches meeting July 31.
